## GED Testing for August

The GED Test will be given at Ozarka College in Melbourne, Arkansas on August 9 & 14 at 8:30 a.m. in Room 516 of the Wyth Duke Adult Education Building.

The test will also be given at the following locations in August:

Mammoth Spring,	Simmons First National Bank	9:00 a.m.	August 7 & 14
Mountain View,	Ozarka College - Mtn. View	9:00 a.m.	August 8 & 15
Ash Flat	Sharp County Courthouse	9:00 a.m.	August 21 & 24
Salem	Fulton County Courthouse	9:00 a.m.	August 28 & 31

You must present an Arkansas photo ID, a Social Security Card, and proof of passing Practice Test scores dated after January 1, 2002. There is no cost to take the GED Test. However, if you plan on taking the test at any of these locations, you **MUST** register by calling Ozarka College at 368-7371 or 1-800-821-4335 before the day of the test. Because of increased demographic information needed, it will be necessary to allow two days for the testing.
